



FREE TAX HELP



The AARP Tax-Aide program, administered by the AARP Foundation in cooperation with the IRS, is celebrating its 42nd year of providing free income tax assistance to low- and moderate-income taxpayers, with special attention to those age 60 or older.

Volunteers will assist in preparing basic tax forms including itemized deductions for personal returns. They CANNOT PREPARE complex Schedule D, Schedules C, E & F, Forms 2106, 3903, 8606 & 8615, and First-time Homebuyer Credit and others. If you have questions, visit one of our sites for advice.

Bring a copy of your completed tax returns from last year, all W-2's, 1099 interest, dividend and miscellaneous income statements, pension income statements, and other tax-related information including that for itemized deductions if applicable. Photo ID is required and you must bring the original issue social security card or ITIN card for each person listed on your tax return. Please bring the amount of real estate taxes paid (even if you do not itemize), so we can determine if you are entitled to an addition to your standard deduction.



Free electronic filing for basic forms is provided by Tax-Aide.
